below we provide you with information that you need to be aware of, not only to comply with legal obligations but also because transparency and fairness towards data subjects are fundamental aspects of our activity.

Who is the Data Controller?

Where is the data collected?

Data is collected through the signing of releases and, in case of consent and authorization, through the taking of photos and videos. Some of these sources are publicly accessible: No.

Is there an obligation to provide data?

Except for purposes based on consent, providing your data is a necessary requirement: failure to provide data indicated as mandatory could have legal and contractual consequences, while failure to provide data indicated as optional could prevent the processing or result in partial processing. Therefore, if you fail to provide it, you might not achieve the expected result or only achieve it partially.

What purposes are the data collected and processed for?

The Data Controller collects and processes your personal data through automated, semi-automated, and non-automated means for purposes related to the collection and subsequent use of multimedia content (e.g., photos and videos, produced graphic materials), mainly based on the consent given by the adult subject or, in the case of minors, by their parental guardians. The <u>table below</u> details data processing activities with information about purposes, legal basis, data types, specific recipients, and deletion terms.

Are there automated processes?

The processing is not based on automated decision-making.

Who are the data communicated to?

In the context of processing activities, your data may be communicated to:

- Authorized individuals, as specified in the specific registry maintained by the Controller, thus employees and other internal subjects
- External subjects processing data on behalf of the Controller, duly instructed and bound by data processor appointment contracts (as identified in the specific registry maintained by the Controller)
- Public authorities upon their request or due to communication obligations incumbent on the Controller
- Other subjects for whom data communication is necessary for the purposes declared by the Controller, as specified for each processing in the table below.

How is the data stored?

Your personal data is stored securely in accordance with identified deletion terms outlined below. However, consider that data may be stored for the time necessary to mature the prescriptive terms related to mutual rights and the time of backup retention.

Is the data transferred?

The processing of personal data (e.g., storage, archiving, and conservation of data on its servers or in the cloud) is confined within the data circulation and processing scopes of the European Union countries, with an explicit prohibition of transferring them to non-EU countries that do not guarantee (or in the absence of) an adequate level of protection, or, in the absence of protective tools provided by EU Regulation 2016/679 (Third country deemed adequate by the European Commission, group BCR, model contractual clauses, consent of the data subjects, etc.). What rights can be exercised?

You have the right to request from the Data Controller access to your personal data and the rectification, deletion, and portability of the same, or the restriction of processing concerning you, or to object to their processing.

If you have given consent for one or more specific purposes, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent given before its withdrawal.
